Educational Travel Grants General guidelines

What is an educational travel grant?

- A financial grant of up to 3000€ allowing an individual to travel to and work in a complying institution for a maximum period of 1 year, to look at a particular technique or research project.

Who can apply?

- Any active European ESVS trainee or full members.
- The applicant's placement should not have started yet by the time of the announcement of successful applicants (May 1st for round 1 and November 1st for round 2).
- Former unsuccessful applicants can reapply as many times as they want.
- Former successful applicants can reapply only if the new placement takes place within a different topic of study.

How to apply?

- Applicants submit an application through the Members' Area of the ESVS website.
- Successful applicants are announced on ESVS website and in the newsletter.

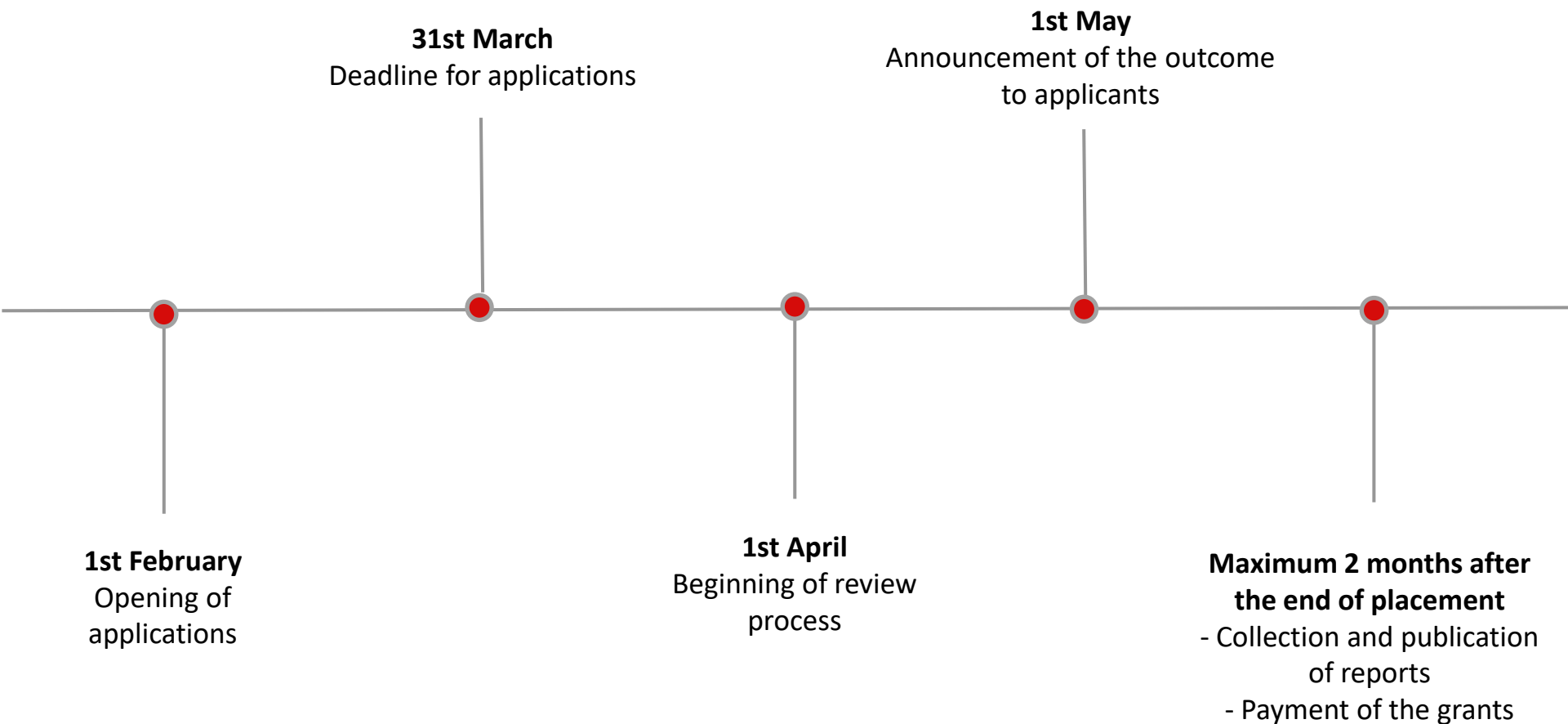
General conditions

- Only the applicant's expenses are covered (no companions or family members).
- Documentation will be required to support the applicant estimation of costs.
- Proofs of expenses, especially accommodation and travel receipts, will be asked after the placement.
- Any cancellation or changes in the placement dates or location should be communicated to the ESVS office as soon as possible.

Payment conditions:

- The estimated amount requested in the application will be paid, up to a maximum of 3000€ per applicant.
- Payment will be processed on receipt of a one-page written report, detailing the learning outcome of the placement. This must be submitted no later than 2 months after the candidate's return.
- The reports will be published on this [page](#). By applying to this grant, applicants accept to have their reports published on the website.
