PRESENTATION OPTIONS

The ESVS Annual Meeting offers two presentation options: **Oral Communication** or **E-Poster**.

Everyone has the flexibility to choose how they want to present their research – either as an oral communication on a big stage or as an e-poster in a more intimate setting using our silent disco mode.

In some cases, the Programme Committee may recommend authors who have chosen an e-poster presentation to present their work as an oral communication. However, the final decision will always rest with the author, ensuring you feel confident and comfortable sharing your research.

**Not comfortable presenting in front of a large audience?
No problem! Opt for an e-poster presentation and share
your work in a smaller, more relaxed group setting.**



ABSTRACT FORMAT



Author(s):

- By submitting your abstract, you agree to serve as the presenting author unless you specify otherwise during submission. You or the designated presenting author also commit to being available at the designated date and time for your presentation. Preliminary schedule of your presentation will be communicated on 1st of July.
- Adhere to the Vancouver authorship guidelines: maximum 8 authors for single-centre reports; exceptions apply to multinational studies.

Body:

Follow this structure:

1. **Introduction:** Highlight relevance and provide context.
2. **Methods:** Describe experimental design, techniques, and statistics.
3. **Results:** Present findings without interpretation.
4. **Conclusion:** Offer supported conclusions and implications.

Layout:

- English only, max 300 words.
- Max 2 tables or figures.
- A table should be created using the tools available on the submission platform
- An image cannot be greater than 750 pixels wide or high. The maximum file size is 1 MB.

References:

- Allowed but not included in the word count.

SUBMISSION POLICY



Unpublished Work: Submitted abstracts must describe unpublished work at the time of submission.

Abstracts previously presented at an **international scientific vascular meeting** will not be accepted. Publishing abstracts from the ESVS meeting in the European Journal of Vascular and Endovascular Surgery (EJVES) will not jeopardize the potential later publication of the full paper in EJVES or EJVES-VF.

Proofreading: Abstracts will be published as submitted. **Please proofread carefully, as no changes, corrections, or author modifications will be allowed after submission.**

Respect the Deadline: The submission deadline is **April 1st, 2026, 23:59**. Late or incomplete submissions will not be accepted. Only fully completed abstracts will be processed. Drafts will not be sent to reviewing.

No Revisions After Deadline: Changes, additions, or removals of authors after the deadline are not allowed.



Authors must avoid mentioning the name of the city, institution (e.g. hospitals, medical centers, clinics), or any other identifiers in the abstract to ensure a blinded review process. While this may be challenging for multinational studies, it is essential to maintain anonymity. **Any violation of this rule will lead to automatic rejection of the abstract.**



REVIEW AND ACCEPTANCE

Blinded Review: All abstracts will undergo a blinded review by 5-7 members of the scientific committee, ensuring fairness in evaluation. Abstracts must be fully anonymised. Any reference to the authors, their institution, city, or the location where the work was conducted will result in automatic rejection.

Evaluation Criteria: Abstracts are assessed based on relevance, scientific value, clarity, and the strength of results.

Notification: Authors will be notified of acceptance or rejection by 26 May 2026, including the presentation format (oral or e-poster).



Recommendation! Ensure you whitelist emails from abstractserver.com (esvs.abstracts@abstractserver.com) to receive important updates.



CONFIRMATION AND PRESENTATION

Confirm by 12 June 2026: Authors of accepted abstracts must complete a dedicated confirmation form by 12 June 2026 to confirm the presenting author and presentation details. **Failure to do so will result in the automatic withdrawal of the abstract and no exceptions to the rule will be accepted.**

Can't present? You can ask your co-authors: If the presenting author is unable to attend, a co-author can present the abstract instead. This change must be indicated in the confirmation form by **12 June 2026**. **No changes will be accepted after this deadline.**

Secure Your Spot: Ensure timely submission of your confirmation form to avoid any issues with your abstract presentation.



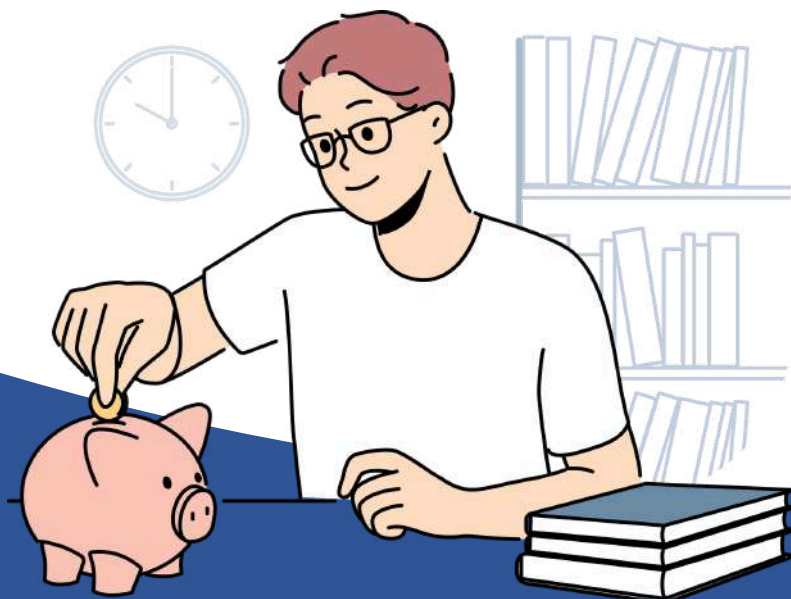
Confirmations after the 12th June will not be accepted under any circumstances, and failure to comply will result in the withdrawal of the abstract

REGISTRATION AND EXPENSES



All presenting authors of accepted abstracts need to register for the ESVS 40th Annual Meeting by **1 August 2026**. Please note that the ESVS does not cover costs related to abstract submission, travel, or accommodation for presenting authors.

Failure to register by the deadline automatically implies that the abstract will neither be included in the programme and congress app nor published in the digital supplement of the EJVES.



Don't forget to take advantage of a €100 reduction on registration fees, available exclusively to presenting authors of accepted abstracts. Please note the discount is only valid until the registration deadline.



PUBLICATION OF ABSTRACTS

Authors who select the publication option and present their research at the ESVS 40th Annual Meeting will have their abstracts published in the EJVES online supplement free of charge.

Publishing abstracts from the ESVS meeting in the European Journal of Vascular and Endovascular Surgery (EJVES) will not jeopardize the potential later publication of the full paper in EJVES or EJVES-VF.
